Greetings, Church family,

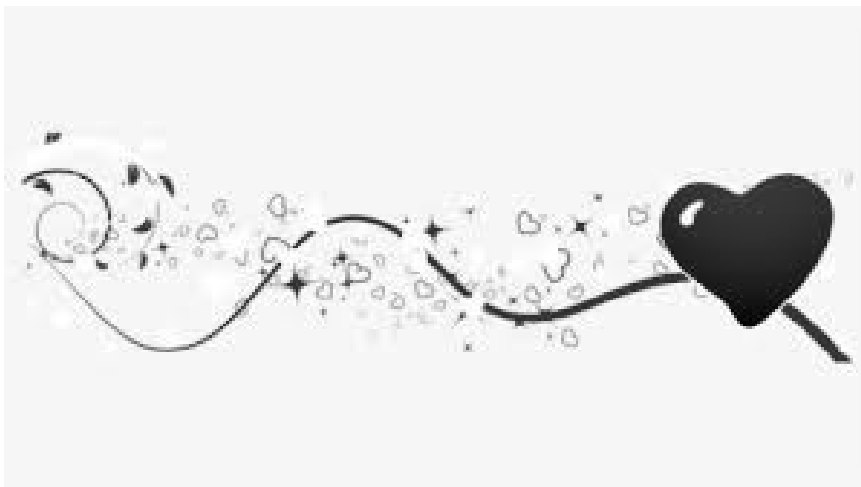
Our school has managed to remain open and in-person for two quarters! We are blessed, especially knowing that many schools have not enjoyed this privilege.
